

1 LA BASTRINGUE R32 · 1RR

Form Big Circle, W on L of M

- 1- All A&R to centre ; repeat
- 9- Circle L; Circle R, finish NHJ with P
- 17- M swings W once under his L arm and into 2 fast turns R in ballroom hold, finish facing cclw RR, W outside



25- All promenade in waist hold, at end form circle, M finding a new P on his L

2 COME UNDER MY PLAIDIE J32 · 2RR

- 1- All turn person opposite RH ; all turn P LH ¾ into promhold, next to other couple (M inside), facing cclw
- 9- Both C promenade once cclw to original places
- **17–** L-Chain (along line of dance)
- 25- All A&R ; All advance [3] passing opposite person Rsh, retire [1] to face new couple

3 PLUTO'S HEAD R32 · 2/4L

- 1- 1M+2W turn RH ; 1c+2c Circle4 L
- 9- 1W+2M turn LH ; 1c+2c Circle4 R
- **17-** 1c lead down {3}, lead up {3} | cast off (2c up)
- **25–** 2c+1c R&L (2,1)



Trio face trio RR.

- 1- Circle6 and back
- 9- Each centre person sets to RH P and turns him/her BH ; repeat with LH P
- 17- Reel3 across, Lsh to RH P
- **25–** In lines of 3 across A&R ; advance Rsh through the opposite line of 3 to meet the next line of 3.

Many variations in handing, polite turns, arches and shoulder exist



- 1-1c set | cast (2c up) ; dance between 3c and cast up to (2,1,3)
- All turn P RH to sidelines ; all chase clw 9half round (to 3x,1x,2x)
- 17-All dance BtoB : all set | all ½ RH turn into
- 25-3c+1c+2c Allemande (2,1,3)



James B Cosh: Twenty Two SCD · Crib: E-cribs · Diagram: Keith Rose's Diagrams

- 1c turn RH | cast (2c up) ; turn LH to 1face 1cnrs
- 9-1c ¹/₂Reel4 with 1cnrs (pass P Lsh); Repeat with 2cnrs
- Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); 17-Repeat with 4cnrs (2cnr person)
- 25-1W+2c & 1M+3c Reels3 across, Lsh to 1cnr
- 33-2c+1c+3c circle6 and back

Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9–24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and sometimes nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".

7 **POSTIE'S JIG** J32 · 4/4L

- 1c+4c set, cast to middle positions 1-(2c+3c step to end); 1c&4c ½ Fig8 round end C (2,1x,4x,3)
- 1M+4M and 1W+4W cross NHJ, (W 9– under men's arch), turn cnr 34 with 'free' hand; 1c facing 4c change places NHJ (arch going up), turn cnr as before
- 17-Repeat (Men's arch; arch going up)
- 25-1c+4c ½ R&L ; turn P RH



8 **ROUND REEL OF EIGHT** R88 · 4S

RSCDS XXVII 7 · Crib: E-cribs · Diagram: Keith Rose's Diagrams

- 1-All W cast by the R and round the set to places
- 9-All M cast by the L and round the set to places
- 17-G-Chain halfway round {6} | all set to P
- 25-Continue G-Chain to places {6} | all set to P
- 33-1c & 3c change places, 1c passing inside {3}, repeat back to places, 3c



- passing inside {3} | 1c+3c turn RH 1¼ into Allemande hold 1c+3c (passing Lsh) Promenade cclw round inside of set to places 41-
- 49-64 2c+4c repeat [33-48] (2c pass inside first)
 - 1c+3c half R&L ; 2c+4c half R&L 65-
 - 73-Repeat [65-72] (to 1,2,3,4)
 - 81-All Circle8 and back
